The Community Cricket Coach will support the Club's desire to establish and deliver a strong community engagement plan in line with the Club's overall strategy. This role will include being a duty manager at appointed times as well as undertaking coaching activities and the individual will work alongside GCCC senior coaches. It is important to understand that at the majority of the hours worked will be at evenings and weekends. The working hours timetable will consistently change throughout the year; therefore, the candidate must be very flexible in their availability to work.
