TICKETS

All ticket purchasers are to enter via Gate 2 or 4. Members are asked to show their membership cards upon entry.

For those who have purchased tickets, e-tickets have been sent to you via email and should already be in your email inbox. Alternatively, you can log in to your account on the ticketing platform to download them.

To make the entry process smoother, consider using your phone to scan the tickets at the gate. For added convenience, we recommend saving your tickets to your Apple Wallet or Google Wallet for quick retrieval.

SEATING

Seating for our Vitality Blast fixtures is unallocated, so you can choose your preferred view of the action. The Jellyfish Family Stand is a no-alcohol zone and blocks nearby will be low-alcohol areas.

Should you need any help or have any questions during the match, our friendly stewards will be more than happy to assist you.

BAG SEARCH

If you are bringing a bag, please leave yourself extra time for entry as this bag will need to be searched and tagged on entry.

The Stadium reserves the right to refuse entry to any person carrying any prohibited items which may be deemed to be offensive, disruptive, dangerous or likely to infringe any party's rights, safety or security, or any dangerous article or substance not referred to below.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- Sharp implements such as knives and forks
- Firearms, weapons, knives and imitation weapons
- Glass bottles and containers
- Alcohol
- Cans (soft drinks or alcohol)
- Fireworks, explosives and flammable items
- Air horns/blow horns
- All musical instruments including whistles
- Gas Containers
- Illegal drugs
- Animals (except guide dogs)

PERMITTED ITEMS

- Personal (folding) umbrellas
- Cooler bags/boxes
- Own foodstuff (with plastic cutlery)
- Soft drinks/water in plastic containers (tops to be removed, although stewards may in certain conditions allow tops to remain – e.g. for medical conditions, elderly people, family usage)
- Cameras and video cameras (for recreational and non-commercial use only)
- Flasks and reusable water bottles
- Small radios, CD/DVD/MP3 players – only with headphones
- Glass containers – perfume, prescription medication, insect repellent
- Aerosol deodorant, medication or insect repellent
